







### **About College Application Week**

Montana College Application Week (MCAW) is a statewide, week-long initiative that takes place each fall. During the week, participating high schools host college application completion events. The goal of MCAW is to assist graduating seniors in navigating the complex college admissions process and to complete at least one admissions application. During MCAW, participating high schools set aside time and space during the school day to give every senior the opportunity to apply to college. The initiative also aims to assist lowincome students, first-generation college going students and those who would not have otherwise considered college. Montana campuses agree to waive or defer the application fee in order to encourage access to all students.


67% of the surveyed applicants during College Application Week qualify for the free and reduced lunch program.

#### Per the MCAW student survey:

\*82% of applicants hadn't applied to any colleges before College Application Week \*49% of applicants stated that they are very likely to attend the school they applied to during MCAW. \*20% of applicants will be the first in their family to attend college.



### **ONE STEP AT A TIME**

- \*75% of seniors surveyed said MCAW greatly improved their understanding of the college application process.
  \*65% of participants said MCAW increased their interest in attending college.
- \*71% of high school counselors stated that MCAW impacted the number of seniors submitting applications to college.
